You **DO NOT** need to confirm your attendance with the surgery. If you are unable to attend at your designated time, please attend anytime that day between 8.30 and 4pm. Again, you **DO NOT** need to tell us if you are changing your scheduled time.

How do I know if I am eligible for a vaccine?

You should have already received a letter in the post from the practice if you are eligible for a flu vaccine. If not please see below the list of recommended groups of patients to have the flu.

- If you suffer with one or more of these health conditions; chronic respiratory, heart, renal, liver, neurological, diabetic or asthmatic (this includes patients on regular inhaled steroids)
- If you take immunosuppressant medication
- If you are a carer for somebody
- If you are pregnant

We have over 3,000 patients to vaccinate in a very short space of time as well as running our normal services; therefore it is very important to vaccinate as many eligible patients as possible at this special one day flu clinic. Please make every effort to attend the Flu vaccination clinic on this day. We have extremely limited capacity to complete your vaccination in the surgery and delaying your vaccination means you remain at risk of this potentially serious illness.

If you are unable to attend the community centre on 13th October at any time during that day, we will have a limited number of flu clinics at the surgery on the week commencing 25th September 2017.
